*A secure nursery for both infants and children up to age 5 is located across the hall from the Fellowship Hall.*

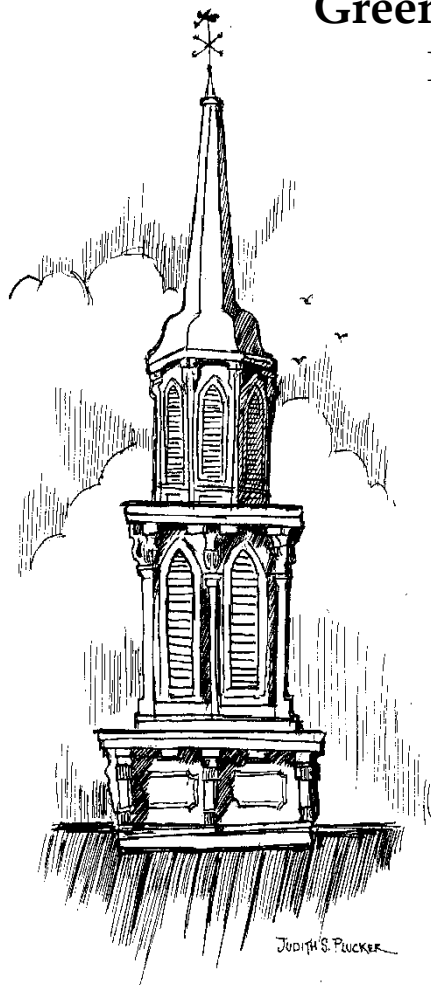
