Position Description and Qualifications

Position Summary:

The Music Ministry Intern of Greeneville Cumberland Presbyterian Church supports the Music Ministry through participation in the Chancel Choir and other opportunities as assigned.

Requirements:

- High school, college, or grad student
- Able to read and sing music—alto, soprano, tenor, or bass parts
- Able to participate in weekly rehearsals (Wednesday or Sunday evenings)
- Able to participate in Sunday morning warm-up rehearsal at 10:00am and worship at 10:30am.
- Able to participate in Christmas Vespers Service (typically the 2nd Sunday evening of December)
- Commitment to achieving learning goals agreed upon with Director of Music
- Excellent communication, notifying Director of Music immediately in the case of necessary absence

Internship Details:

- Students will be interviewed and auditioned by the Director of Music prior to being offered a Musical Agreement.
- Students will be paid up to \$200/week (payroll is by automatic deposit twice monthly)
- Students will work with the Director of Music to establish 3 learning goals over the duration of the internship that are of special interest to the student and beneficial for the church.
- Students are required to attend Chancel Choir rehearsals, worship services, and other music ministry events listed in the Musical Agreement. More than 2 weeks of absences will result in termination of the agreement.
- Internship runs from September 2026 to the beginning of May 2027.
- Students will be given an opportunity to attend Montreat Worship & Music Conference in the Summer of 2027.
- Students will be given a one-year membership to PAM (Presbyterian Association of Musicians).

Music Ministry Interns work under the direct supervision of the Director of Music, but as part-time employees of the church are answerable to the Senior Pastor, Personnel Committee, and ultimately the church Session.
